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Adult Education Budget Data

The Adult Education Budget (AEB) provides residents in South Yorkshire who are aged 19 or over and not in employment, education, or training, with access to free skills support and training programmes.

Through the AEB, our employed residents can also take part in skills development programmes and training that may help to progress in an existing job or move into a new career, traineeship, an apprenticeship or progress in learning.

The programmes offered through the AEB are completely free of charge to the learner and are delivered by organisations: Further Education colleges, local authority training providers, independent training providers and voluntary, charity and community associations.

The AEB is a funding stream intended to fund provision which supports the local labour market and economic development. In particular, it focuses on ensuring that adults have the basic and core skills they need for work, including guaranteeing a number of statutory entitlements relating to literacy, numeracy and digital skills.

For South Yorkshire the devolved AEB will play a key role in the region's agenda from the 2020/21 academic year, linking with other activity aimed at supporting residents into productive and sustained quality employment, as part of an integrated education, work, skills and health system. The South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) is a public authority and the Data Controller for the information that is provided to it by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) to provide the Adult Education Budget funded provision.

Learner information collected by the ESFA is known as the Individualised Learner Record (ILR). The specification and standards for the ILR are published for each academic year by the ESFA.

AEB Occupancy Report - August to January 2022 (R06)

The key data used to produce AEB Data Publications are Single Individualised Learner Records (ILR) collections provided to the South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) by the ESFA.

The Education and Skills Funding Agency sponsored by the Department for Education.

Destination data is provided for learners who had completed or left all learning activities (learning aims) they were enrolled on during the period August 2021 to January 2022, who have a destination outcome recorded. Providers have two months from the latest completion/withdrawal date to enter a destination outcome.



This means not all learners who have completed or withdrawn from all learning activities in the period will have an outcome recorded. Additionally, there is no limit to the number of destination records that can be returned for each learner. More than one record can be recorded with the same outcome start date, although they must have different outcome types/code combinations. The number of outcomes therefore does not equal the number of unique learners with a recorded outcome. In this first year of devolved funding we have no directly comparable data to consider alongside this set.

Wherever in-year data is used, it represents provisional, reported to date figures. These are updated in subsequent data returns and should not be considered the final record of provision in that time period. We acknowledge that as such it is incomplete and in particular the data lags behind the actual mid-year position in relation to Community Learning.

SYMCA aim to publish data for the end of the Academic Year in Winter 2022.
